



Kindergarten Teacher

Overview:

The Kindergarten class is for 5-year-old students and enrollment is limited to approximately 18 students. The classroom teacher is responsible for teaching and directing all core activities, including circle time, Bible, Literacy, Math readiness, centers and story time.

Kindergarten students also have the following specials (taught by other teachers): Spanish daily), Physical Education (twice per week), and Music, Art, Library and Computers (weekly). During these classes, the classroom teacher has planning time.

The Kindergarten teacher has one full-time assistant. The assistant helps with playground supervision, classroom support, working with students needing additional assistance, supervising students during specials classes and preparing classroom materials.
